

NÆSHUSENE

Næshusene is not a holiday center. Each house has its own owner; furniture and other items must not be removed from the houses.

It is important that all users help keep the area tidy and presentable for everyone to enjoy. Please respect everyone's privacy and behave in a friendly manner at all times.

HOUSE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Music and noise.

- Keep music and other noisy behavior at a level that does not disturb other residents.
- The area must be quiet in the hours between 11:00 PM and 08:00 AM.

Communal areas.

- The lawns around the houses are private land and users of the Næshusene are welcome to use them for recreational activities.
- Be respectful of other users when using the communal areas.
- The lawns must be tidy and free of personal belongings.
- Open fires and fireworks are not allowed.
- Barbecues are restricted to the individual house's patios or the barbeque area near the playground.
- Larger outdoor parties are referred to the barbecue area near the playground.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead and the owner must clean up after them. Dog waste bags are available at the recycling hub.

Patios.

- The patios must be kept clean and tidy; they may not be used for storage.
- Please don't dry clothes or towels on the fences.
- Do not climb the fences.

Recycling hubs.

- The refuse sorting rules must be observed by all users.
- Please take great care to dispose of your refuse in the correct skip:
- General household waste.
- Cans and plastic packing recycling.
- Paper, newspapers, cardboard and plastic wrap recycling
- Food waste
- All other types of waste must be taken to the local recycling centre at Torø Huse Vej 15 in Assens.

Parking.

- Cars, motorcycles, scooters, trailers, etc., must be placed in the parking area.
- Bikes must be placed in the stands at the end of the sheds.
- Larger boats, caravans, etc. must be parked on the marina area, by the sailing clubs or at the campsite.
- No driving or parking is allowed on the lawns, the paths and the beach.

Compliance.

The caretaker oversees the area daily and may ask that the house rules and regulations are adhered to.
